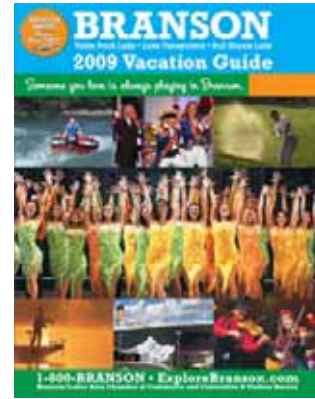
Foothills Members Plan Trip to Branson, Missouri

Tour price *per person* is \$543 double occupancy; \$525 triple; \$505 quadruple; and \$778 for single. This fee includes motor-coach transportation, motels, lake sightseeing adventure, Shoji Tabuchi theater, Hillbilly Jamboree show, dinner cruise on the *Branson Belle*, five full breakfasts and three dinners.

Reservations with a \$200 deposit are due ASAP, and the final payment must be made by August 21, which is also the cut-off off date to sign up. First 40 people will receive priority guarantee. Departure time and location will be announced later.

The one and one-half millionth Corvette was recently built at Bowling Green. In the fifty-six years of production, other milestones have been #1 30 June 1953, 250,000th-1969, 500,000-1977, and 1,000,000-1992.

Because all 1953s were white with red interior, all of these milestone models have been white with red interiors also.
