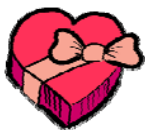


Valentine Party Postponed Until February 27

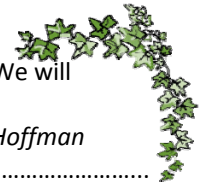
