The meeting was then turned over to Kendall Hendrix, the newly elected president who asked for everyone's support in the coming year.

Holding a 2009 cruise-in was discussed. While feelings were mixed, a tentative date of June 6 was set. It was agreed that the weak link last year was publicity.

This year's event will be open to any GM car. More on this and committees needed will be discussed at the January 25 outing. Ebenezer Children's Home will again be the club charity.

It was suggested that the club have some social activities other than rides and use Saturday sometimes. The
