Group Plans for 2011 Cruise-In and Changes Meeting Schedule

Foothills Corvette kicked off the new year with its January planning meeting that was held in Granite Falls. There were 32 members and two guests in attendance.

President Kendall Hendrix asked for an update on members who are sick or have experienced family losses. (See page 2) Although she was not present, he showed the group a plaque for Carol Royal honoring her two years as treasurer. Carol did not run for re-election.

Last year we began keeping attendance at all group functions with the aim of honoring those who had attended the most events/meetings during the year. This first year produced a tie between two couples. Sharing this honor were Allen and Claudette Icenhour and Bill and Rachel Reavis.

Quarterly meetings have been getting longer and longer as there is usually much to discuss. Therefore, the club is going to bimonthly meetings. Last fall it was decided to move these to the first Tuesday of the month rather than the second. Business meetings will now be the first Tuesday of each odd numbered month. (January, March, etc.)

Kendall acknowledged the fact that hosting a cruise-in as we have done in the past has become a tremendous undertaking for a group our size. He proposed that this year club members would only have to sell advance raffle tickets and on the day of the event, be there to sell raffle and 50/50 tickets and park cars. Registration and food sales would be handled by outside groups. This plan was agreed to and May 21, 3:00 to 8:00 p.m., was set as the date and time. The raffle this year would be for \$1000 cash.
